The York Rite consists of four distinct but separate sovereign Masonic bodies:

The Symbolic Lodge

The Chapter of Royal Arch Masons

The Council of Cryptic Masons

The Commandery of Knights Templar

THE BODIES OF THE YORK RITE

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

Each individual group is called a Commandery. Each Commandery confers three Orders or Chivalric Orders of Christian Knighthood. Freemasonry demands only a belief in a Supreme Being, whereas Commandery provides transition to the ideals of Christian chivalry. They consist of these Orders:




The Illustrious Order of the Red Cross tells the story of Zerubbabel securing permission to rebuild the second temple of Jerusalem and is a simple lesson of the powerful testimony to the almighty force of TRUTH, which is a divine attribute and the foundation of every virtue. It is designed to impress upon you that there is but one God and that human nature changes, but little, over great cycles of time.

The Mediterranean Pass and Order of Malta. First called Knights Hospitalers of St. John of Jerusalem. It was the first organized body whose avowed purpose was the aid and care of those injured on the battlefield. As the candidate you represent a knightly warrior of the Crusades prior to your departure for the Holy Land.

The Order of the Temple refers to its members as "Soldiers of the cross". Though not historically connected to the Knights Templar of that warring period of the Crusades, today it is motivated by the same principles - the protection of the weak and oppressed, the relief of the distressed and the defense of the Christian religion. It is widely regarded as the most solemn and impressive experience in Masonry.

ROYAL ARCH

The first three degrees of Symbolic Masonry are the first steps to the York Rite, the Royal Arch Masonry degrees continue the journey.



Each individual group is called a Chapter. The Chapter confers four degrees (Capitular Degrees), giving a complete story of Masonic symbolism in the following order:

The Mark Master degree is perhaps the oldest Masonic degree and is one of the most highly respected. It teaches practical lessons for everyday living. This degree supplements the Fellow Craft degree. The Mark Master degree teaches the use and lessons of the "Mark" each craftsman used to distinguish his work in the erection of the temple. It demonstrates how the craftsmen received their wages.

The Past Master degree teaches the candidate the important duties and responsibilities of the Oriental Chair and its qualification for advancement. It also teaches that he who would rule over others must first learn to rule himself.


The Most Excellent Master degree is based upon the completion and dedication of the Temple and the lessons taught in it and amid much rejoicing. It is commonly known that the symbolism of Freemasonry surrounds the building of this Temple.

The Royal Arch degree is the completion of the whole system of Freemasonry. It is said that this degree "is the most sublime and the very summit of perfection in ancient Masonry". It is in this degree where they discover the missing treasures at the rebuilding of the Temple, that which is lost in the Master Masons degree is restored to the Craft. No other degrees are so intimately linked to the Blue Lodge.



CRYPTIC

Each individual group is called a Council. The Council confers three degrees (Cryptic Degrees). These degrees are conferred in the following order:



The Royal Master degree directly precedes the Master Mason degree. Without this degree and the **Select Master** degree the Master Mason degree and the Royal Arch degree would be incomplete. They are known as the "Degrees of preservation". These two degrees account for the concealment and preservation of the treasures revealed in the Royal Arch degree. The central figures in the degree are our three ancient Grand Masters and a fellowcraft. The Royal Master is the only degree in Freemasonry where the candidate "meets" our Grand Master Hiram Abif.

The Super Excellent Master degree teaches the beautiful symbolism of Faith, Friendship and Fidelity. This degree is the most dramatic and spectacular of all Masonic systems.
